


The following guidelines are to be adhered to at **ALL** times until further notice.

Cromwell Lake

28th - 30th August 2020

- Hand Sanitiser and a Facemask will be provided to each person on arrival in your goodie bags, which are prepared in a sterile environment.
- It is essential to keep at least 2 metres apart, no physical contact and if you feel the need to cough or sneeze, please ensure you keep it to yourself!
- Peg visits will be permitted providing social distancing is adhered to. **2 Metres at all times. And no more than 6 people in a group.**
- ALL photographs of catches MUST be taken from a distance of more than 2 metres if someone is taking the picture for you. Their own device must be used, and the photo sent to you. STRICTLY NO SHARING of Camera's, Phones etc.
- Please ensure you bring plenty of essentials and **arrive fully prepared**. This will reduce the need for non-essential travel and unnecessary movement around the fishery.
- If you **feel unwell** at any time, **you must inform Tremayne immediately.** This includes a new cough, a high temperature and/or a loss of taste and smell.

The procedures in place will be strictly monitored and actions will be taken if they are not followed. You WILL be asked to leave the venue. These guidelines are in place as per the current government guidelines and are also applicable as part of the fishery rules. Be Safe, Stay Aware, **Don't get sent home!**

BBQ RULES

The BBQ will go ahead as usual, adhering to social distcancing rules. A one-way system will be in operation, keeping a safe distance between your Chefs, the Food and Yourselves.

- Social Distancing must be adhered to at ALL times. At least 2 metres apart and no contact.
- There will be **a one-way system** in operation and **clearly marked**, keeping your food and you safe. Please follow any further instructions given on the day.
- Disposable Gloves will be provided to wear while you collect your food. Please dispose of them safely on leaving the area. A bin will be provided for this.
- To minimise risk, please ensure you collect the food you would like, in one visit.
- There will be **an area set aside to eat**, however, social distancing rules but be followed (more than 2 metres apart) and there will be clear boundaries marked.
- ALL used plates and utensils must be disposed of safely, and in the bins provided if eating within the social area, before returning to your peg.
